2022 League Goals & Guidelines

Overall Goals for the Program:

To provide a safe and fun environment which involves improving skills, learning fundamentals, and team play.

Coaches Teaching Objectives:

Safety: Controlled atmosphere, applying rules

Encouragement: Positive reinforcement

Responsibility: requiring commitment to attendance and improving good listening skills

Team Play: teaching players to work together

Fun Competition: active involvement and instruction

Equal Involvement: everyone plays an equal amount, everyone receives individualized attention

Improved Skills: Constant feedback and training from the coaches through repetition

Parental Concern:

If any parent has a concern, please talk with Sam Scheffler at 616-7432. Feedback is always welcome because often times it can serve to improve the program for all the participants.

Weather Cancellations:

In considering any cancellation, the player's safety will be the most important factor.

KLGR AM will broadcast all cancellations as early as possible. DO NOT CALL KLGR. You may call the Weather Announcement Hotline at 616-7443 or the RACC at 616-7444. You can also get signed up to receive a weather announcement text or email by going to our website at www.redwoodareacommunitycenter.com

Arrival Time:

We ask participants to arrive ON TIME, ready to start play. We also need to make sure your child is picked up on time, because there are times when our coaches need to get to another field. When dropping kids off at the High School Fields please do not drive on the service road for the safety of the participants! Please park in the RACC lot and walk to the fields.

Girls Softball League Playing Rules (10:15a-11:30a)

-The distance of the bases will be 60'

-Batter will get 7 pitches to put the ball in play. After 7 pitches the batter will be asked to sit down and it will result in an out.

-This is a coach pitch league or we may use the pitching machine.

-5 Innings Games or 1 hour 10 minutes.

-A ½ inning consists of three outs or a team scoring a max. of 5 runs. If the offense scores 5 runs in one ½ inning and the defense doesn't record 3 outs, the runners left on base will be put at the same base the next inning. The last inning of each game, teams are allowed to bat until 3 outs are recorded.

-A player may not play one position more than two innings during the course of any one game. A player's position is up to the coaches' discretion.

-No player will sit more than 2 innings during the course of the game.

-Everybody will be in the batting line-up regardless if they are playing in the field at the time. Lineups are at the coach's discretion.

-Runners can't advance on passed balls.

-Practice attendance will be kept. Unexcused absences will affect playing time and batting order. (Basketball, hockey camps, etc. are excused. Please notify the coach one (1) week ahead of time.

-10 run rule after five innings.

-15 run rule after three innings.

-The ruling on the field for all calls is final.
